Metro

Head into Sunderland with Tyne and Wear Metro service. Choose between a variety of tickets to match all needs and journeys - either hop on and off the service or head straight to your final destination.

Trains run every 12 minutes Monday – Saturday daytime, and every 15 minutes on evenings and Sundays.

CAR

Sunderland's central train station is just a short walk away, running timely services through the evening. For a visit to Sunderland's forward thinking University, depart at the designated City Campus station.



Sunnyside

Park Lane & Holmeside

CAR

Park up at Boughton Street 6, Bridges Multi Storey 3 and Civic Centre 8 car parks for direct access into Park Lane and Holmeside.

INTERCHANGE

Arrive and leave Sunderland city centre through Park Lane Interchange, where bus and metro services run frequently.



Retail Quarter

From high street retailers, a market loved by generations, designer boutiques and a street of independent traders - there's something for everyone in Sunderland's Retail Quarter. Finish your shopping trip with coffee and fresh cakes at one of the city's independent or well-loved national coffee shops.

CAR

The Bridges 3 & 4 and St Mary's Multi Storey 1 car parks are your one stop for the easiest retail parking in the city.

BUS

Regular services run from Park Lane Interchange and Fawcett Street to help you transport those heavy shopping bags.

METRO

Jump off at Sunderland's central train station and you're in the heart of the city, with all your favourite stores right at your feet.

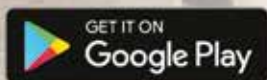
